

NATURE/OUTDOOR ADVENTURE SPECIALIST

Supervises: Sr. Counselors and Jr. Counselors

Purpose of job: To provide campers with structured activities using various nature media. To provide a safe, positive and enjoyable group/nature experience.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. To plan an educational 8 week program for children aged 4-12 which will explore an interesting and challenging variety of nature media. Submit detailed lesson plans a week in advance.
2. To implement this program in a positive, enjoyable manner.
3. Attend camp orientation and other staff meetings as scheduled. Participate in all camp activities including special events and Family Fun Day.
4. Maintain a safe and constructive environment for campers. Encourage campers and provide them with a positive view of themselves, others and the camp.
5. Be a role model for all junior and senior counselors by following all policies, procedures, and regulations .
6. Prepare rainy day plans and implement when needed.
7. Plan and/or assist in implementing Camper's Chance/All Camp Games activities throughout the camp season.
8. Supervise children and summer staff on the playground. Be alert to and address any safety issues immediately. This includes AM/PM coverage at the Girls Club and Free Play coverage at camp.
9. Follow the Girls Club behavior plan.*
 - a. *While introducing activity/lesson Sr/Jr handle behavior issues, however once activity has started if you see an issue, you should address it.
10. Must be able to lift 50 lbs.
11. Organize, maintain and clean storage room and nature shack area including supplies, lesson plans and all other related equipment.
12. Any additional duties as assigned by the Director and Asst. Director.
13. Follow Girls Club Professional Conduct policy.
